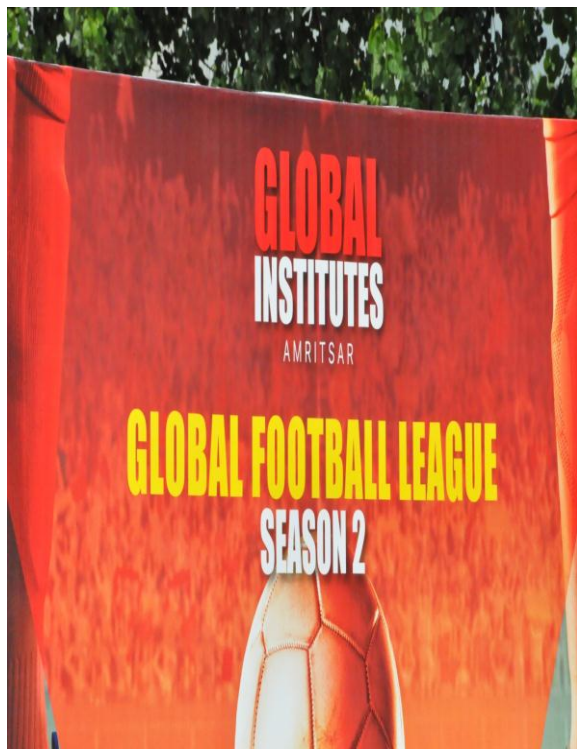

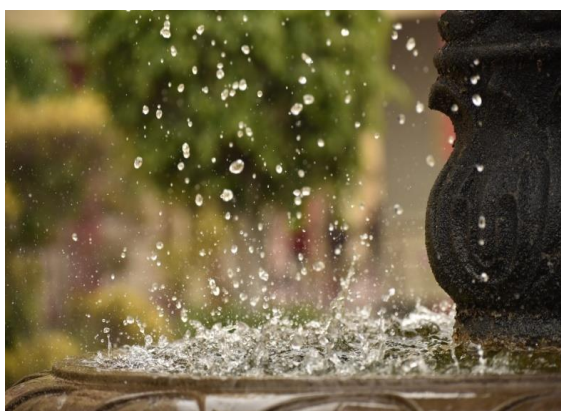
“Debate Competition” on 14-02-2017
