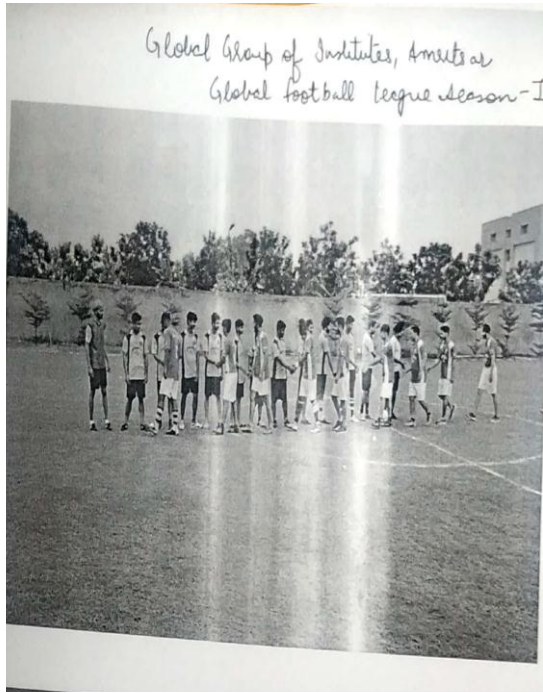

## Cultural Activity on 6<sup>th</sup> February 2020

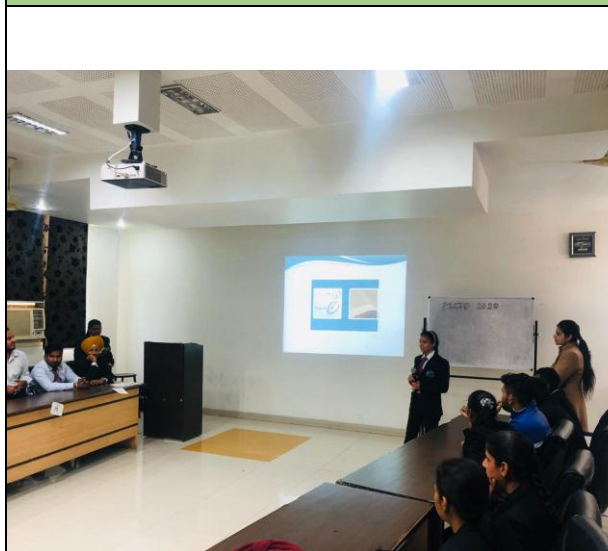

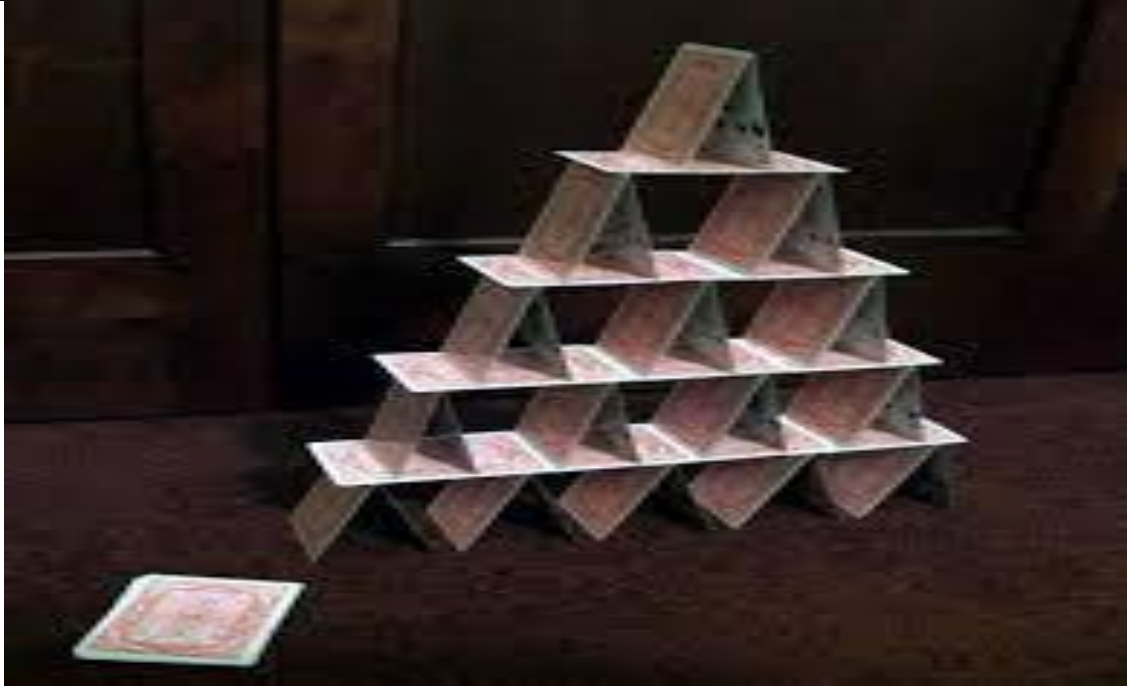
### **Debate Competition on 23 August 2019**
