Report on Student Satisfaction Survey For

Academic Year 2021-2022

Global Group of Institutes (GGI) being ranked the top among the engineering colleges in Amritsar and accreditation by NAAC strives to reach greater heights with continuous feedback especially from the major stakeholders, i.e. our students. By asking students to rate their satisfaction and priorities, institutions can quickly uncover strengths and challenges where they should focus their attention and resources. These surveys will need to create new benchmarks for the post-pandemic environment, as Institutes begin to document how satisfied students are with institutional actions, support systems, hybrid instruction, and overall safety measures.

The objective of Student Satisfaction Survey is to measure the student's level of satisfaction on their experiences with Global Group of Institutes (GGI) covering the areas as shown in the tabular form and to identify the address gaps for process improvement. The institutional level survey comprises 19 parameters, with a benchmark of 80% and a minimum student sample size of 60%. The survey for the Academic Year 2021-22 was conducted online during the months of May/June 2022. The results were collected and tabulated electronically for analysis.

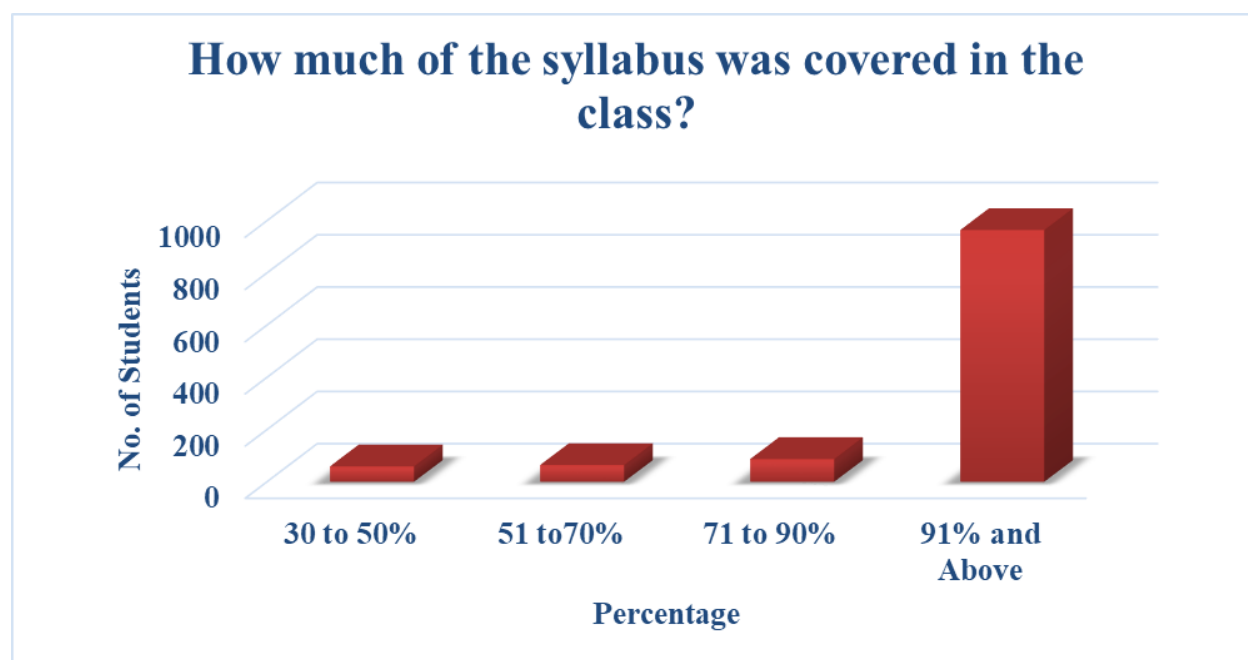
