
BIG DATA AND CLOUD ON 26-10-2021

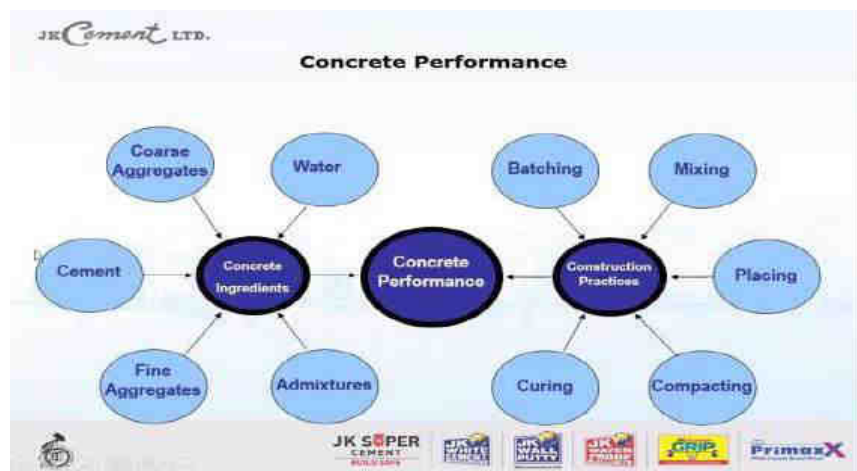

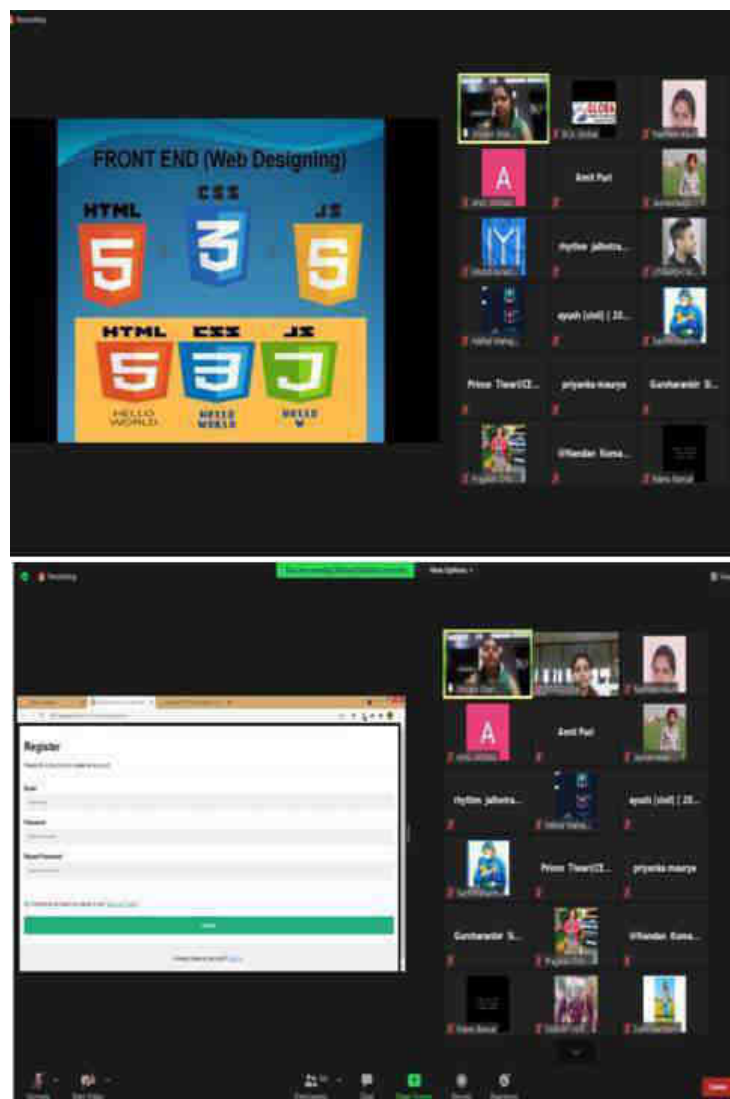
NEW AGE CONSTRUCTION SOLUTION ON 26-06-2021

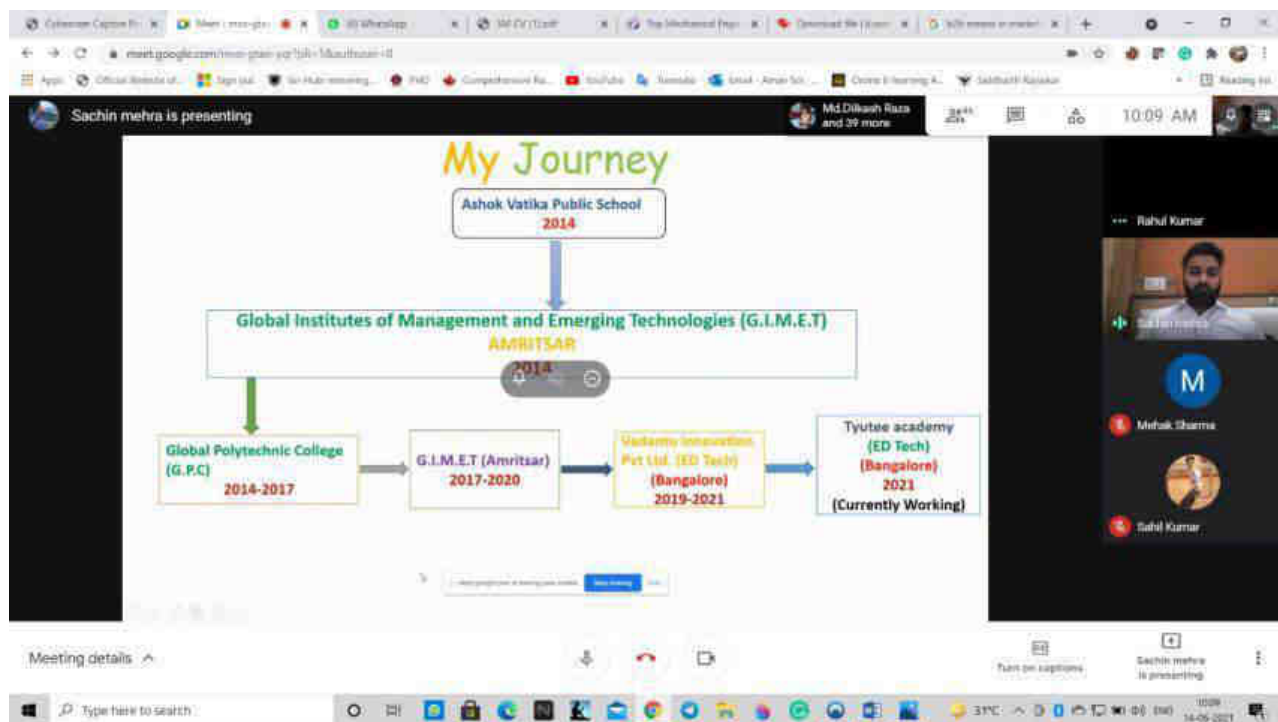

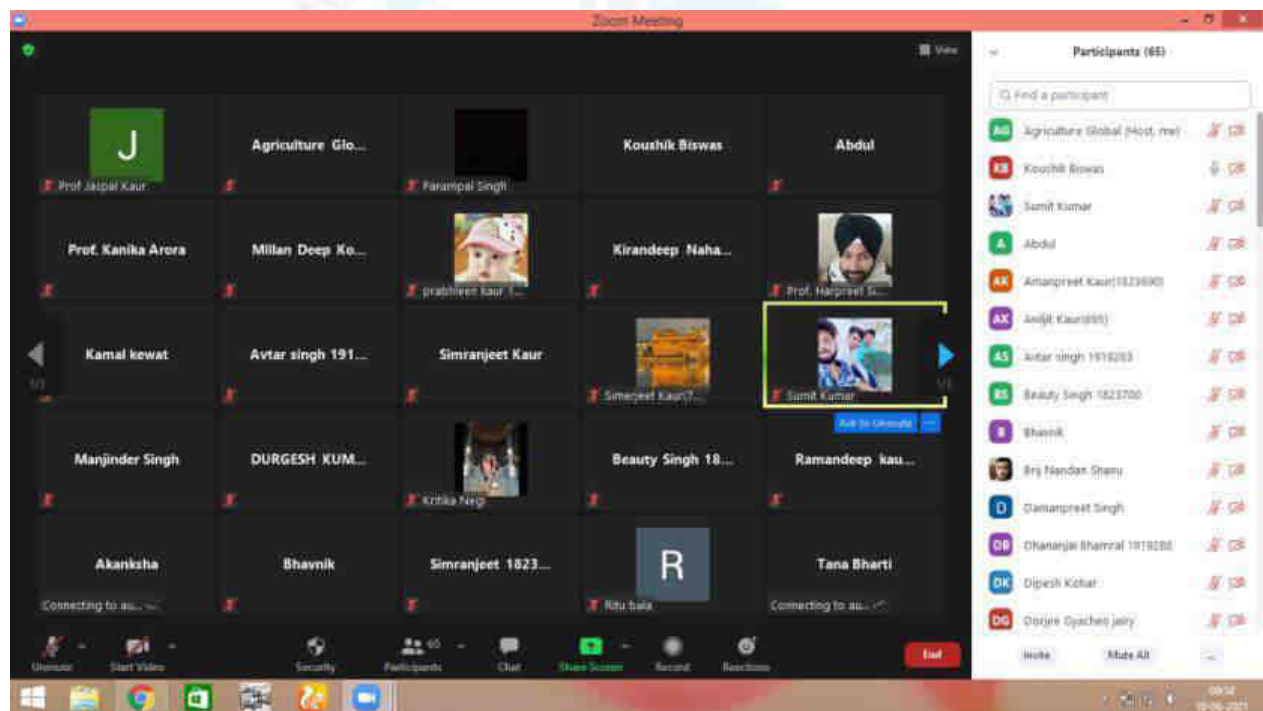
EDUCATION & TECHNOLOGY INDUSTRY ON 14-06 2021

ONLINE WORKSHOP ON HANDLING DATA USING MYSQL ON 05-06-2021

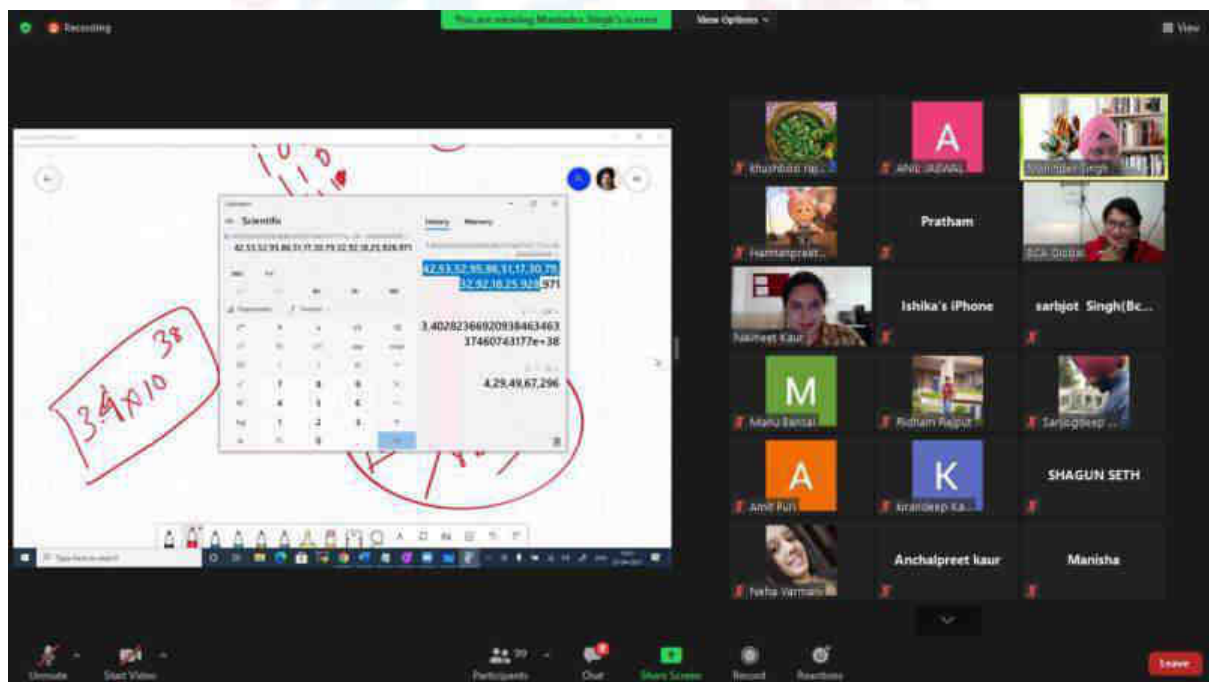

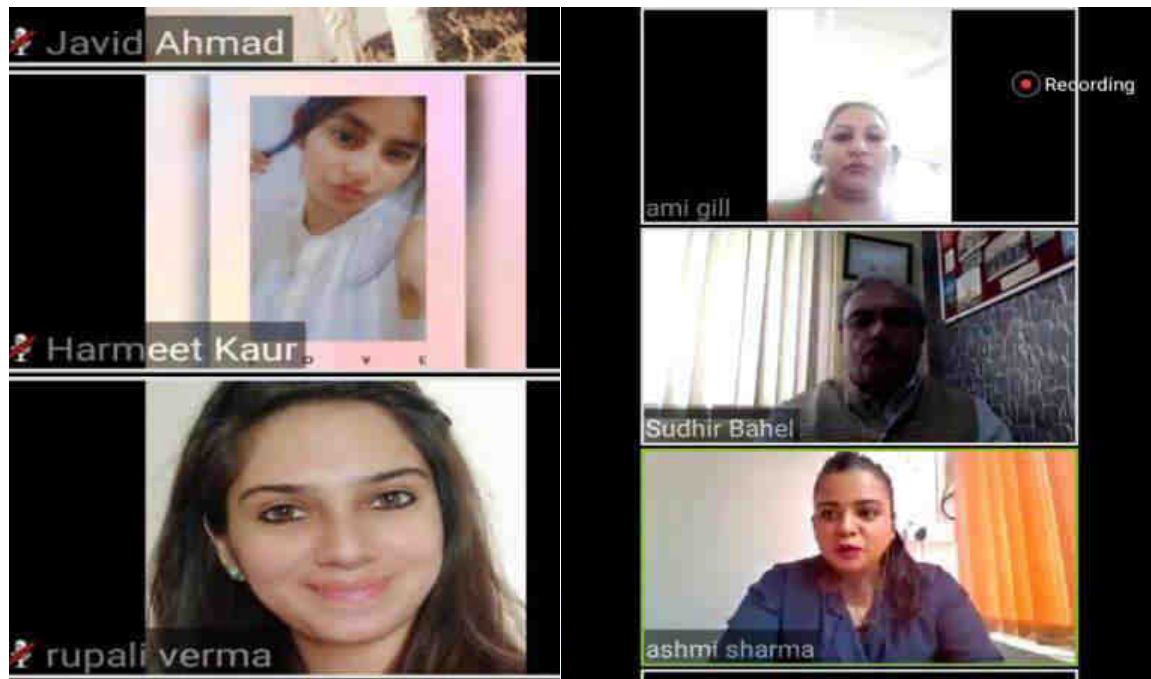
ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT ON 01-04-2021

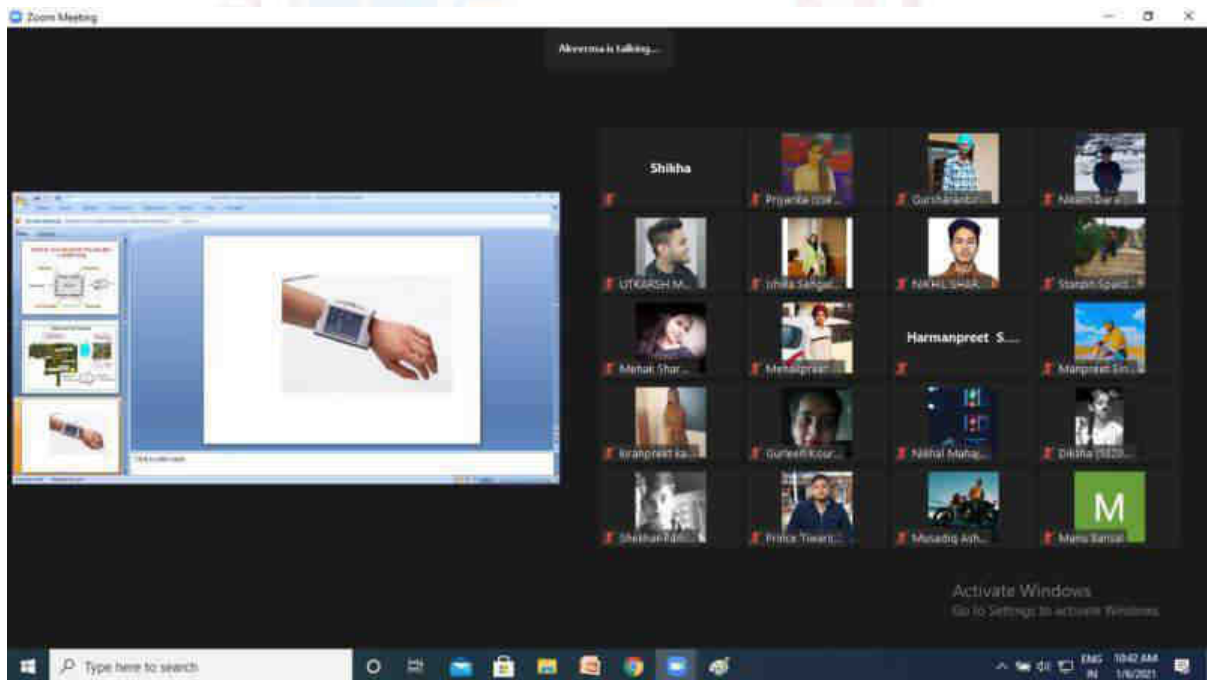
NANO TECHNOLOGY AND DIGITAL CIRCUIT DESIGN ON 26-02-2021

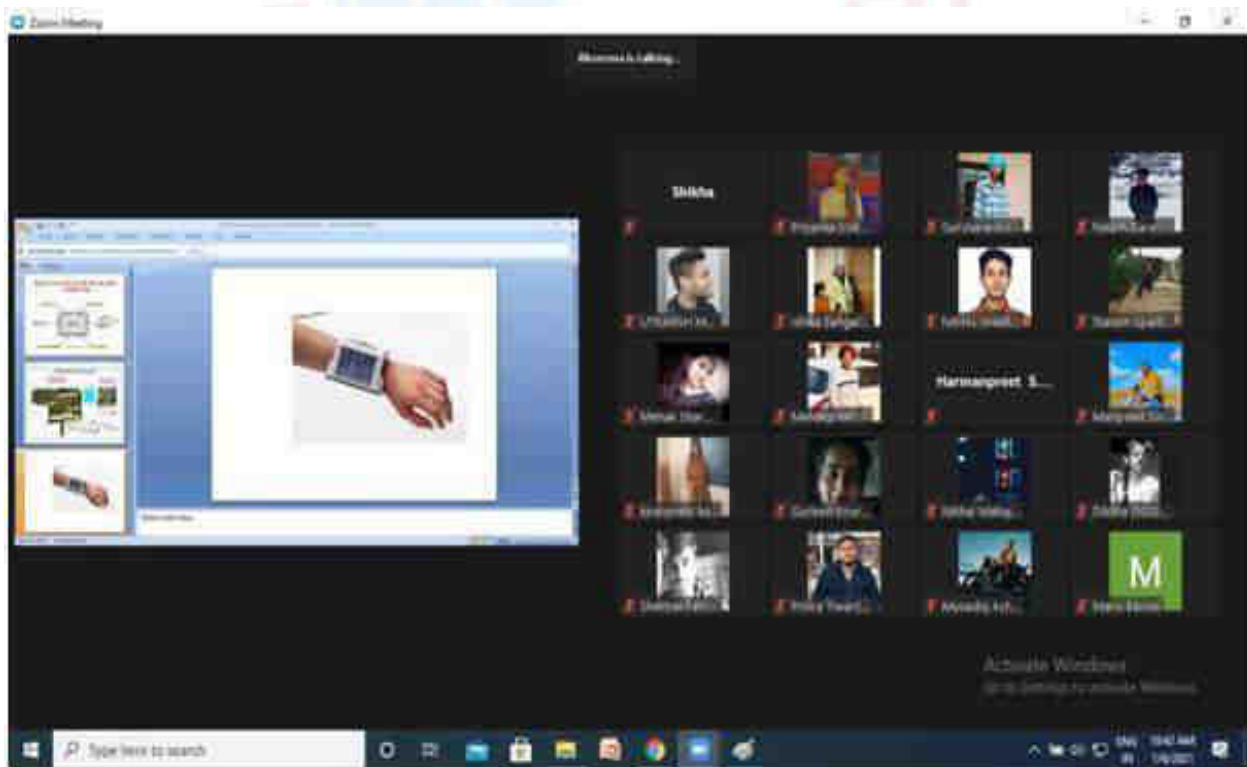
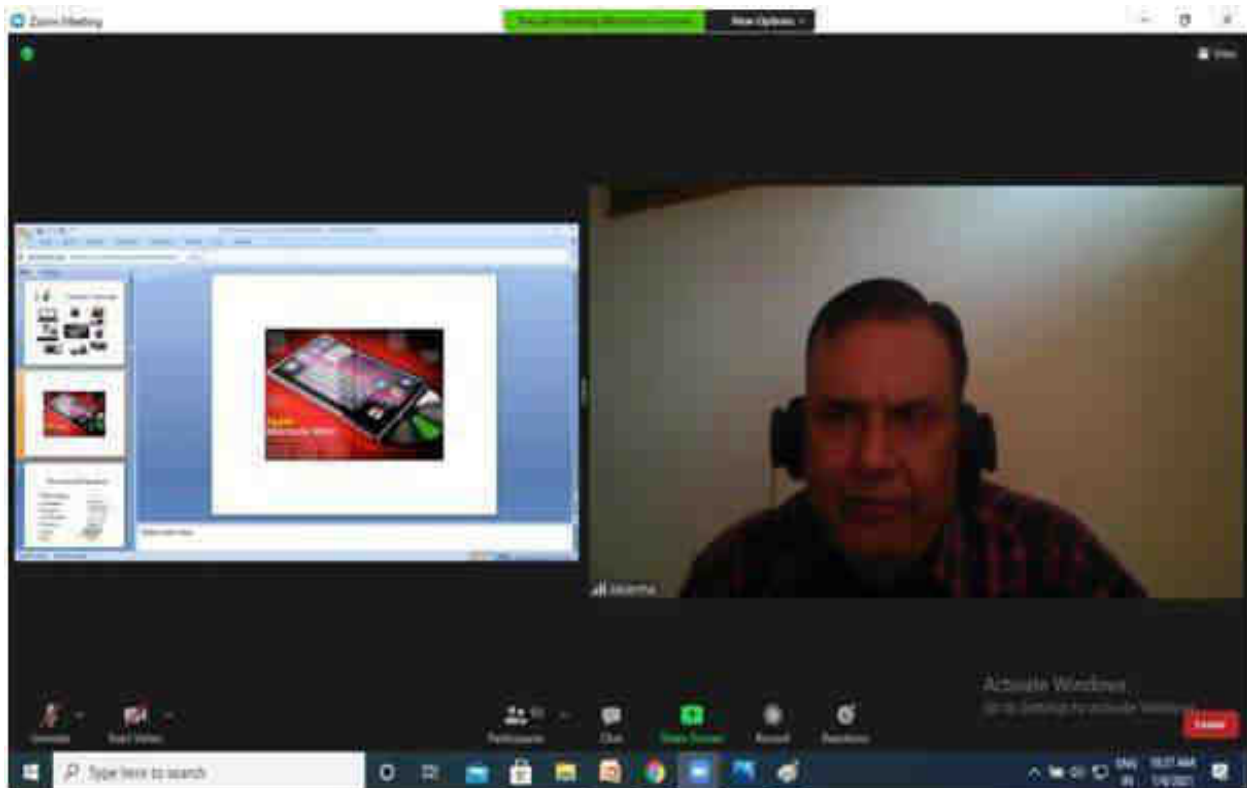

ONLINE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM ON WEARABLE COMPUTING ON 06-01-2021

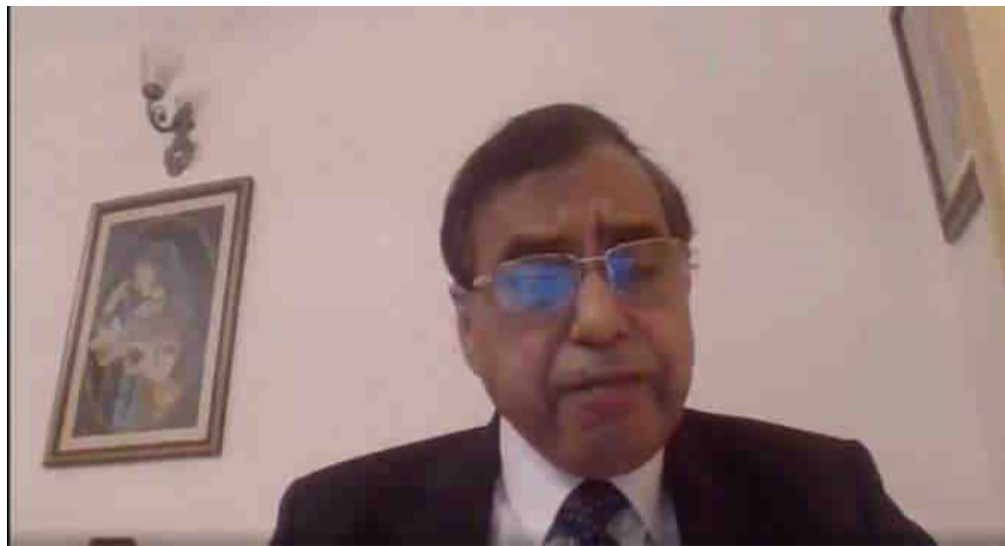

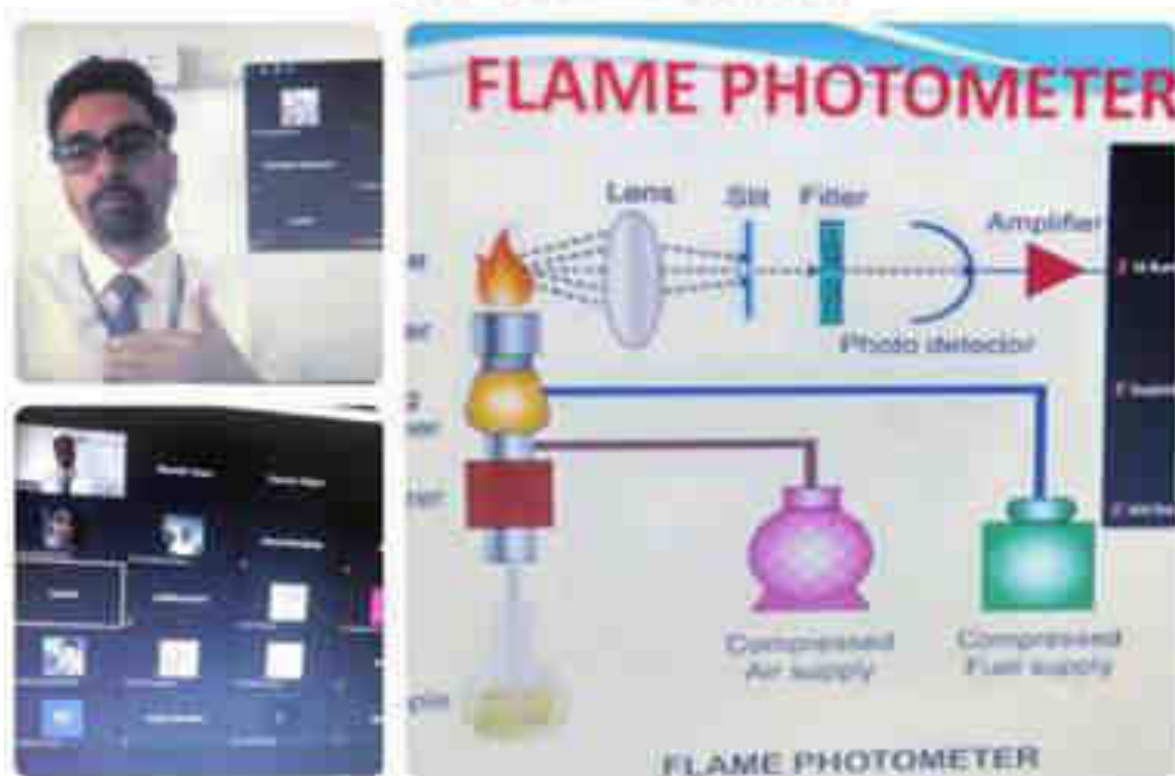
CHANGING SCENARIO IN INDUSTRY ON 12-11-2020

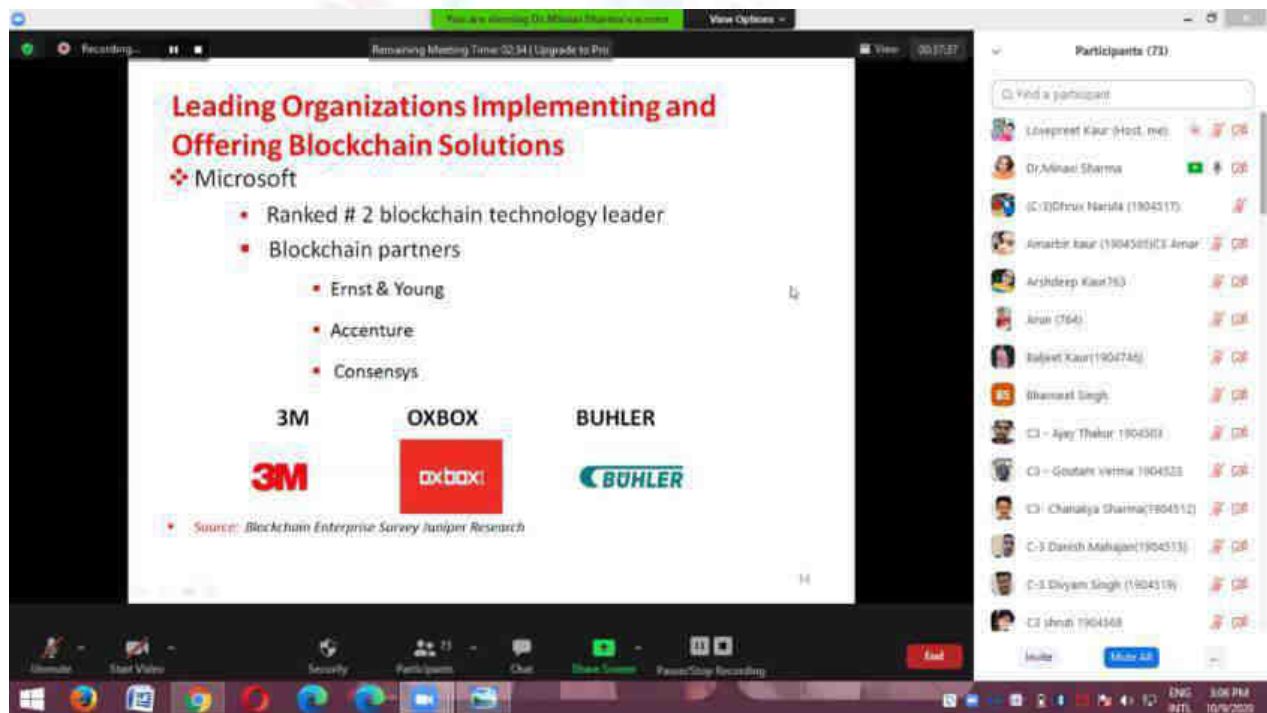
INTRODUCTION TO MLS & ANALYTICAL TECHNIQUES USED IN LABORATORY ON 30-10-20

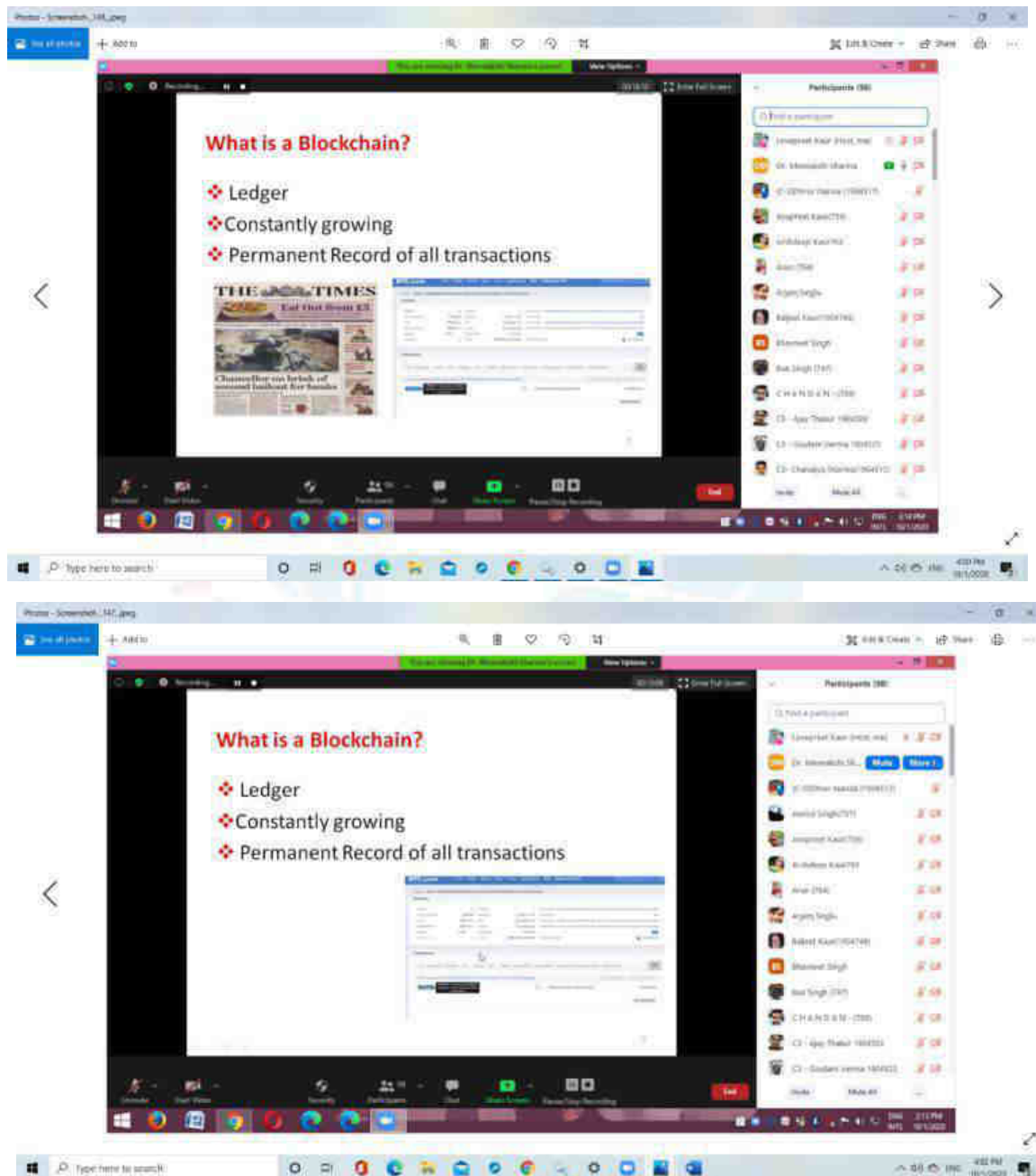
BLOCK CHAIN PART 2 ON 09-10-2020

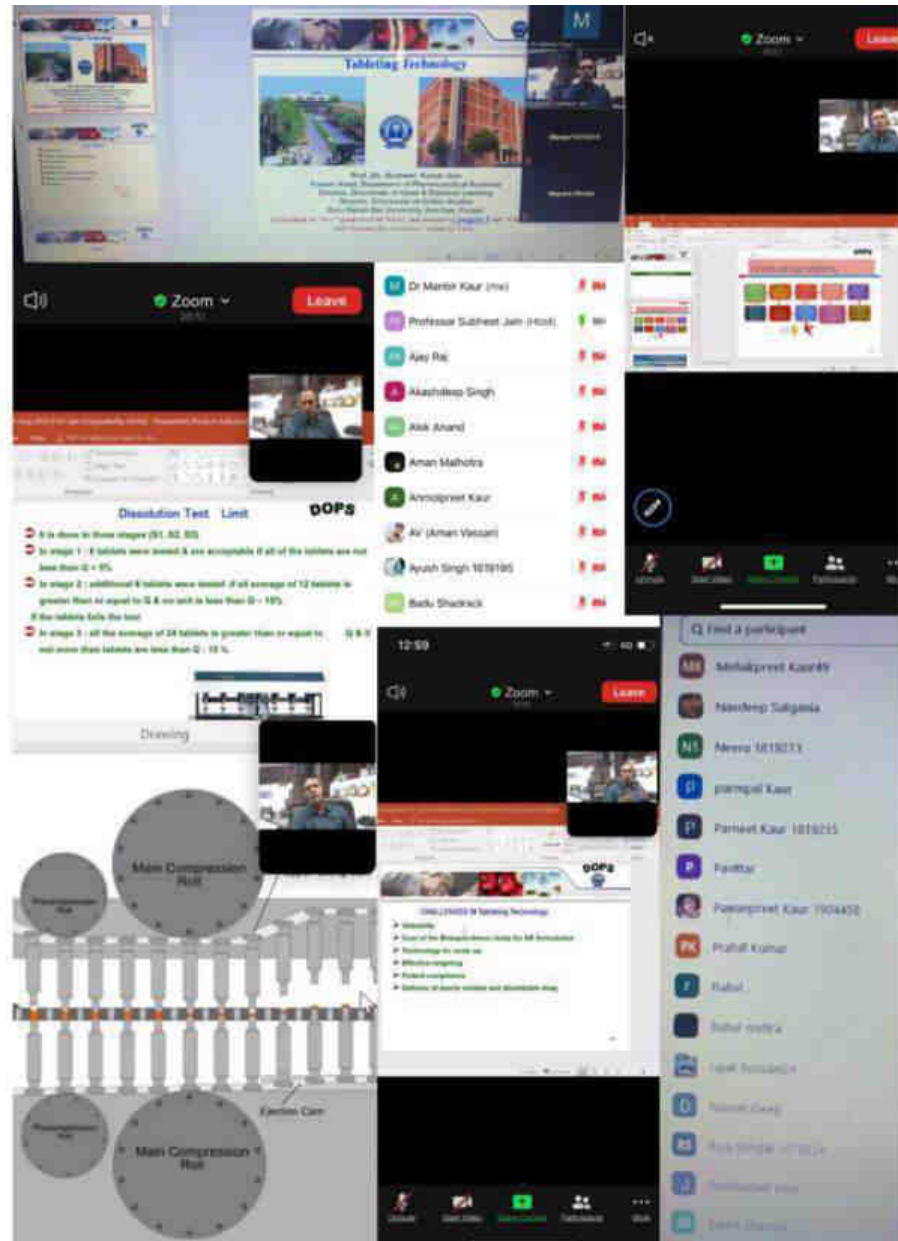
TALENT ACQUISITION IN STARBUCKS ON 26-08-2020

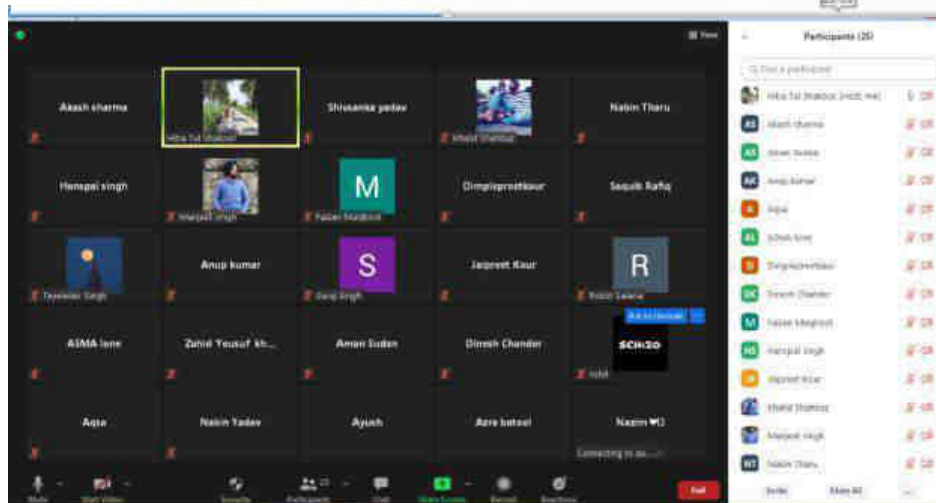
WEBINAR ON STRESS MANAGEMENT ON 13-06-2020

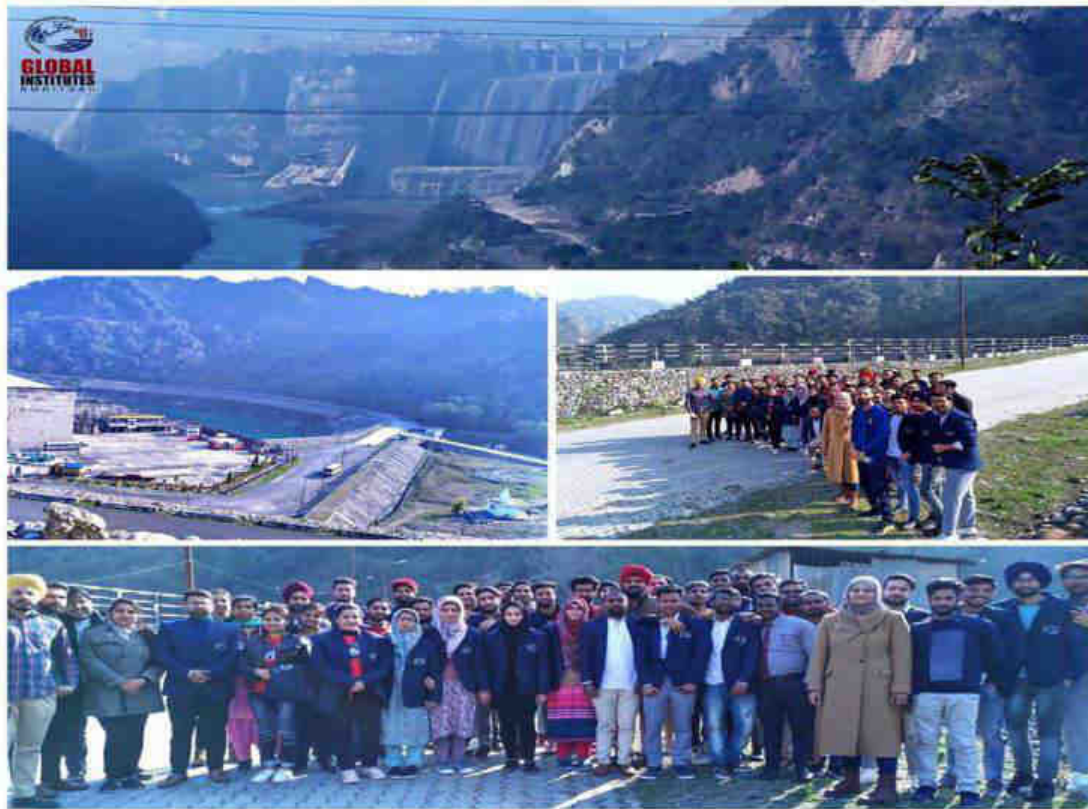
INDUSTRIAL VISIT AT VERKA MILK PLANT, VERKA AMRITSAR ON 13-02-2020

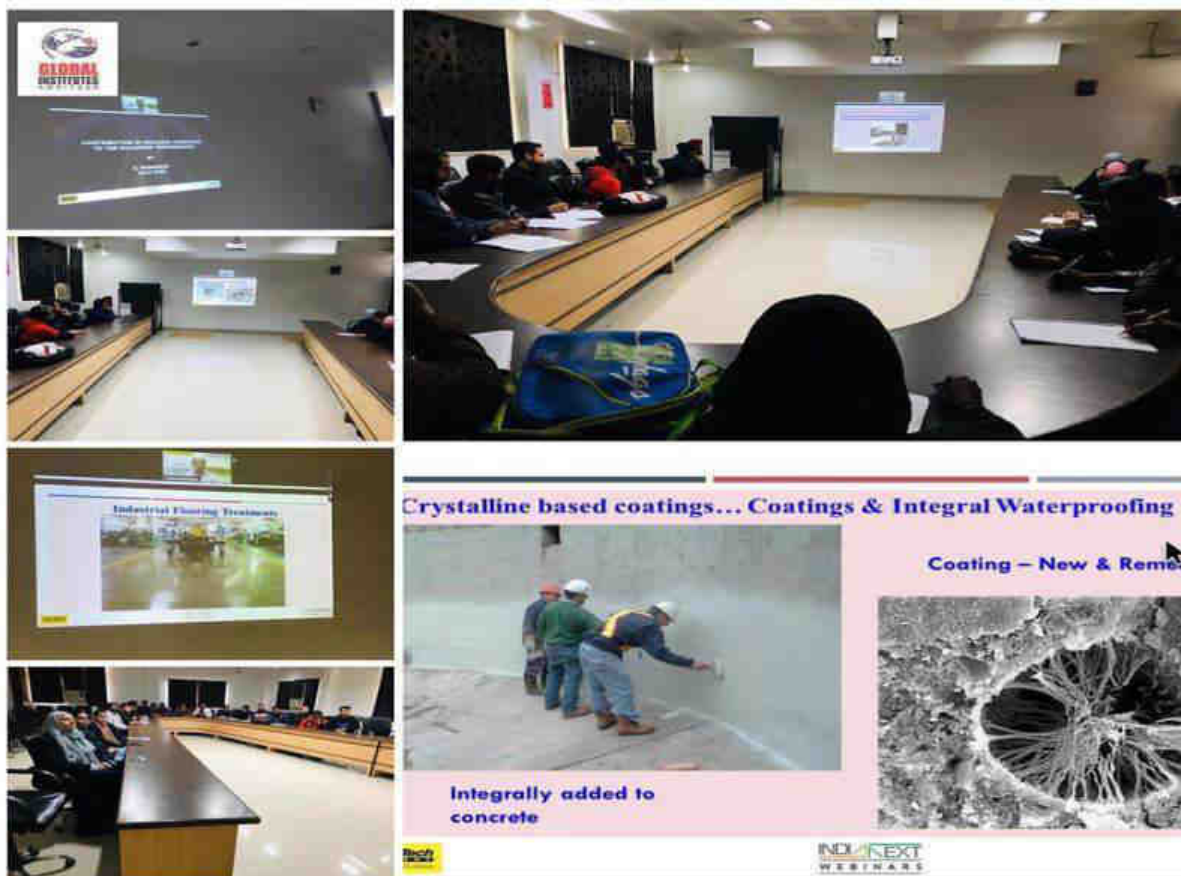
EXPERT TALK ON MARKETING: THE WAY OUT OF RECESSION BY DR. D.S HUNDAL ON 30-01-2020

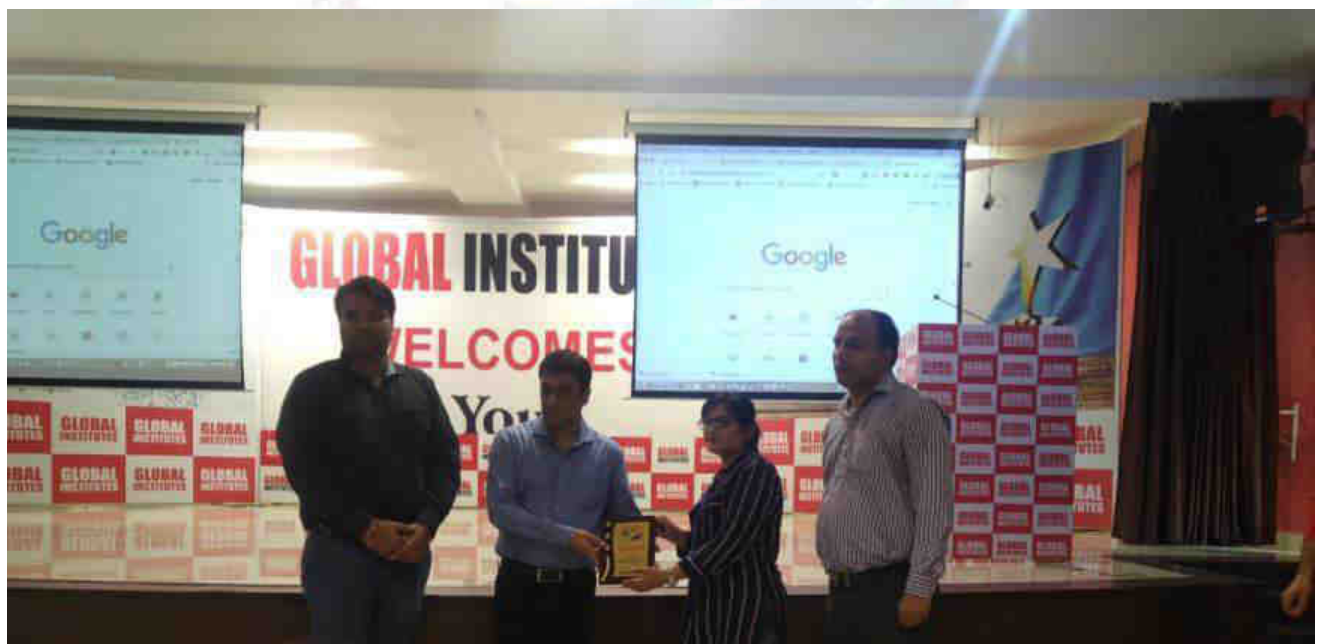




ANDROID APP DEVELOPMENT ON 19-09-2019
