They also informed us about HPV vaccines and the need to get vaccinated. Vaccination against HPV prevents new infections, but it does not treat existing infections or illnesses. This is why the HPV vaccine is most effective when administered prior to any HPV exposure.






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DENGUE AWARENESS RALLY




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AD-MAD SHOW




