BEST PRACTICES (2016-2017)

The institute has adopted various best practices over a period of time. Some of them are given below:

(i) ONE SEMESTER/SIX MONTHS TRAINING: Training Placement Cell of the institute provides employment opportunities and industry oriented training to the students in the leading organizations. As a part, this institute has long lasting practice of giving opportunity of six months training to the final year B.Tech, MBA & MCA students in collaboration with various industries. Many industries/corporate houses approach the training and placement office for selection of students for this six/ seven months training. They train these selected students in the real industrial environment. Many industries also provide handsome stipend during the training period. This six months training is made mandatory and forms a significant part of their curricula. Faculty members of the respective departments are appointed as mentors for each student who assess their progress during training time to time by visiting the industries where these students are working. The industry is also advised to appoint a mentor at their level and give the students any suitable projects so that students concentrate on his/her work effectively.

(ii) TRANSPARENT EVALUATION SYSTEM: The institute is in practice of delivering a transparent evaluation system, whether it is internal or external semester examination. As part of continuous evaluation, tests are carried out in two sessions. After evaluation of these tests the answer sheets are shown to the respective students to maintain transparency. Before finalization of marks again the students are allowed to see their answer sheets on a given date so that any doubts may be cleared within time.

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
