

**International Memorandum of Agreement
Between
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH ALABAMA (ALABAMA, USA)
And
GLOBAL INSTITUTES (AMRITSAR, INDIA)**



This International Memorandum of Agreement by and between the University of North Alabama (hereafter referred to as "UNA") and Global Institutes Amritsar (hereafter referred to as "GIA"), hereby agree to the following terms for educational collaboration between the two universities.

I. SUMMER STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM (June Session, July Session or June + July Session)

1. UNA agrees to accept qualified GIA students to as J-1 non-degree study abroad students during the summer sessions.
2. UNA summer courses are only offered with sufficient enrollment of a minimum of ten students. Each summer course can be completed in one month (June or July) or in two months (from June to July). GIA students are required to take two face-to-face courses (6 credits) to be in compliance with J-1 student status during the summer sessions.
3. GIA students will pay the regular international student tuition and fees at UNA based on the six (6) credits.
4. A minimum TOEFL score of 61 (internet-based), IELTS 5.5, PTE 46, or TOEIC 600 is required.

II. GLOBAL STUDIES CERTIFICATE PROGRAM (Spring or Fall Semesters)

1. UNA agrees to accept qualified GIA students to participate in the value-added Global Studies Certificate Programs (GSC) at UNA as J-1 non-degree study abroad students.
2. The purpose of the GSC programs is to provide international students to have a unique study abroad experience in the United States while earning a special certificate that enhances their global career opportunities. The curriculum design of each GSC track contains Introduction to Global Studies, one international component course, and three major core courses. (Course listings are included in the Appendix).
3. GIA students of all majors are eligible to apply and may choose a Global Studies Certificate among several career fields including Computer Information System, Marketing, Management, Nutrition, Exercise Leadership, Health Promotion, Sports Management, and other professional fields in Communications, International Relations, Technical Writing, and American Studies when available.
4. The GSC Program requires 15 credit hours (5 courses) and to be completed within one semester (fall or spring).
5. GIA students will pay the regular international student tuition and fees at UNA based on the 15 credit hours.
6. UNA agrees to provide a number of UNA Partner School Student Scholarships (\$500/semester) to selected GIA students when funds are available.
7. A minimum TOEFL score of 61 (internet-based), IELTS 5.5, PTE 46, or TOEIC 600 is required.

III. MASTER DEGREE PROGRAM

1. **3+1 MBA Degree:** applicable to students with an earned BBA degree; some pre-MBA businesses may still be required based on a student's BBA degree curriculum and GPA.
2. **3+1 MPS Degree:** applicable to students with an earned bachelor degree.
3. **3+1+1 MBA Degree:** applicable to students with a non-BBA degree.

4. Programs Available:

- A. **MBA (Master of Business Administration)** (Concentrations include: Professional, Accounting, Finance, Health Care Management, International Business, Computer Information System, Project Management, SAP-ERP)
- B. **MPS (Master of Professional Studies)** (Concentration includes: Community Development, Information Technology, Security and Safety Leadership, etc.)

5. Admission Requirements for Double and Master Degree Programs:

- A. An official GIA transcript showing a grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.00 scale.
- B. A minimum TOEFL score of 79 (internet-based), 213 (computer-based), IELTS 6.0, PTE 54, or TOEIC 670 for Master's Program. (Students who do not have TOEFL/IELTS are exempt from the test by taking ESL program at UNA.
- C. A minimum GMAT score of 450 is required for the MBA Program. MPS program does not require GMAT/GRE.
- D. GIA students will pay the regular international student tuition and fees at UNA.

IV. **AGREEMENT IMPLEMENTATION AND DURATION**

- 1. This agreement will be administered by the respective Office of International Affairs at UNA and at GIA.
- 2. Each university shall designate an individual who will serve as the responsible officer for this agreement. These officers are responsible for the execution of all aspects of this program. The designated responsible officers for this agreement are:

- 3. This memorandum is valid for five years and becomes effective on the date that it is signed by the official representatives of both universities. This agreement will be reviewed and may be renewed upon mutual consent of both parties at the end of the fifth year. Either party may cancel this agreement upon one year's advance notice to the other party. In such case, all GIA students enrolled at UNA will be allowed to complete their intended programs before the agreement can be terminated.
- 4. Two (2) original copies of this agreement shall be prepared and signed by the university officials from both parties and each university keeps one original on record.

V. OTHER INITIATIVES

Both UNA and GIA agree to explore other international cooperation initiatives including joint conferences and workshops of mutual interest to further enhance educational excellence and opportunities at both universities.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



BETWEEN

ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY, U.S.A.

AND

GLOBAL INSTITUTES AMRITSAR, PB (INDIA)

Legal and Financial Status of Memorandum of Agreement

- Neither this Memorandum nor any following agreement is a contract to create legal and/or financial obligation outside those financial and logistical arrangements specifically listed in the General Conditions of this memorandum. This Memorandum and its subsequent agreements are designed solely to facilitate the development of mutually beneficial and collaborative initiatives.
- Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding or any agreement concluded in pursuance thereof, no agency is created between the parties.
- Parties using their existing resources shall share all costs associated with the implementation Of this MOU ASU and GLOBAL INSTITUTES AMRITSAR, PB (INDIA)

- May refer to this program in their catalogs and other appropriate publications.
ASU representative Mr. Rajan will serve as the liaison between ASU and GLOBAL INSTITUTES AMRITSAR, PB (INDIA).
- He will assist with presentation of information and assist with student application process.
- This Memorandum of Understanding is to be in effect with the 2015-2016 academic year and will be valid for duration of five (5) years.

This MOU will become effective immediately upon its ratification by individuals who have authority to execute such agreements at the two institutions and after they have obtained any necessary confirmation by the internal curricular bodies of the partner institutions and by the appropriate higher authorities of the respective countries. Either institution may terminate this MOU at any time. In so doing, the duly authorized representative of the Institution initiating such action shall give written notice to the other party at least six (6) months prior to the end of the academic year then in progress, unless the parties mutually agree upon an earlier termination date. Nothing in this clause, however, shall be interpreted to the detriment of any student.

Memorandum of Understanding

It has MOU with many National & International organizations for academic, research, faculty development, student exchange etc programs. Students are from different states of India and international countries Nepal, Bangladesh, Afghanistan, Ghana etc. Excellent ambience for academics & sports attract students to these institutes in the complex.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made between Eternal University, Baru Sahib, Himachal Pradesh and Global Group of Institutes, Amritsar- Jammu High way, Amritsar to promote academic and research cooperation and the development of these two institutions as Centres of Excellence of higher and technical education and scientific research. The two institutions agree to the following broad terms of cooperation:

1. Both the institutions will support each other's endeavors in delivery of academic programmes and research activities through the following but not limited to:
 - (i) Exchange of scientific and technical information
 - (ii) Joint supervision of Postgraduate and Ph.D. students.
 - (iii) Undertaking collaborative research activities through participation in nationally and internationally funded projects.
 - (iv) Jointly organize events such as seminars, workshops, conferences and training programs
 - (v) Training of students of both institutions as per the facilities and resources available
 - (vi) Any other objective as agreed upon in writing by both the institutions
2. Both parties acknowledge and understand that all financial arrangements, if any, will be subjected to prior written agreement and availability of funds for each activity/project undertaken.
3. The MoU remains in place for a period of five years from the date of signing of the agreement and may be renewed for a further period of five years or such time period as may be agreed upon by both the parties in writing.
4. No party shall have the right to use the name or logo of another party without the prior approval of that party in writing.
5. The terms of this MoU may be modified/amended at any time subject to mutual written agreement. Such modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which both the parties execute them in writing.
6. The MoU may be terminated by either party by giving 3 months written notice. In the event of termination, both the parties shall ensure that the interests of students/ongoing projects under this MoU are safeguarded to the extent possible.

Responsibilities of the Parties

Both parties mutually agree to identify various areas of interest and depute faculty/staff as per the requirements with mutual consent. The inviting institution shall meet the travelling expenditure and any honorarium/remuneration as may be applicable. The inviting institution shall make necessary boarding and lodging arrangements for the deputed person.


Both the institutions shall identify for accomplishing the above laid down objectives. Each party shall attempt to make such faculty available as and when required.

Every individual research collaboration will have separate agreement/terms of contract that addresses issues such as Intellectual Property Right (IPR), funding pattern, disclosure of confidential information etc.

In the event of any dispute or difference arising in the implementation of the MoU, such disputes shall be resolved amicably by mutual discussions by the signatories (or any higher officials deputed) of both the institutions. All such decisions shall take into account the status of students/ongoing projects under this arrangement and the interest of such students/projects shall be guarded as much as possible.
