Rules for the Various Events

Solo Singing Competition

PRIZE MONEY

- 1st Prize: - Rs 3000/-**
2nd Prize: - Rs 2000/-
3rd prize: - Rs 1000/-

- One student per school.
- Time allowed 3-4 Minutes.
- Only Hindi or Punjabi or Urdu or English songs are allowed.
- Note: Professional **accompanists** are allowed.
- Recorded music/ Karoke is allowed

Group Dance Competition

PRIZE MONEY

- 1st Prize: - Rs 10000/-**
2nd Prize: - Rs 5000/-
3rd prize: - Rs 3000/-

- Only one team per school, comprising of 6-10 participants.
 - Time allowed 5-6 minutes.
 - Dance style categories: Cultural/ Western/ Indo-western.
- Recorded or live music is allowed

PRIZE MONEY

Rs 5000/- Each

- There can be maximum four participants from each School (2 Male participants and 2 Female participants).
- Participants will be given time and place to change their attire during the transition.
- **Round 1:** Casual Wear Modeling.
- **Round 2** (Finale)
 - 6 Female participants and 6 Male participants will be shortlisted to proceed to the finale.
 - The theme in the Finale will be "Formal Evening Wear" which includes the following:
 - For Girls: Evening Dress or Evening Gown
 - For Boys: An Evening Suit

- There will be a Question and Answer Round, where participants can be asked questions that will judge their presence of mind and their knowledge and intellect about the on goings in and around the world.
- Judgment criteria will be based on the personality, walk, dresses and wit.

RULES TO BE FOLLOWED:

- One team per School.
- A Team consists of 1-2 Students.
- The Team Will Make 1 Cake. (Either Dry or Icing)
- Oven and Cake Moulds will be provided by the college.
- Participants can carry their Ingredients and Special Equipments with Them.
- Judgment will be done on the basis of Texture, Taste, Color & Theme.
- Duration of event 3 hours

DUMB CHARADES

PRIZE MONEY

1st Prize: - Rs 3000/-

2nd Prize: - Rs 2000/-

3rd prize: - Rs 1000/-

- The players will be divided into two teams. Each team consisting of 2 members.
- Word /movie name will be written on chits.
- Only one person (Actor) will come in front to get a chit from the bowl with a word or movie name.
- Actors will stand at least 5 feet away from partners.
- No sound or lip movements are allowed. Actor cannot point to object or person to show something.
- Actor will have 2minutes to explain the movie name and if their team will guess the correct movie, they will get 1 point.
- Duration of the competition: 2 hours.
- Judge's decision will be final and should be accepted by all.

FACE PAINTING COMPETITION

PRIZE MONEY

1st Prize: - Rs 3000/-

2nd Prize: - Rs 2000/-

3rd prize: - Rs 1000/-

- Maximum 2 students per school
- One student is to paint the face and other student lends his/her face for painting.
- Theme for the event is:
 - Save Nature
 - Any Festival
 - Women Empowerment
 - Gender Inequality
- The medium of face painting should be Face Painting colors, poster colors etc. Additional material can be used. Students will bring their own colors.
- Student can use half of the neck instead of full, while painting. But painting coverage should not be more.
- Duration of the competition: 2 Hours
- It is compulsory to give the presentation of the painted face.
- Mobile phones are not allowed during the event.

POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

PRIZE MONEY

1st Prize: - Rs 3000/-

2nd Prize: - Rs 2000/-

3rd prize: - Rs 1000/-

- Not more than 3 students per school are allowed.
- Each Participant can submit only 1 poster.
- Time duration: 2 hours.
- Color composition will be done on half imperial sheet.
- Topics will be announced on the topic.
- At the backside of the poster, participant has to mention his/ her name.
- Participants can use pencil, crayons, sketch, water color, etc.
- Participants have to bring their own colors and posters.
- The poster will be judged on the basis of creativity, message, presentation, neatness and overall effect.
- Violations to any of the above-mentioned rules will lead to the disqualification of the contestants.
- Judge's decision will be final and should be accepted by all.

JUST A MINUTE (JAM)

PRIZE MONEY

1st prize: Rs 3000/-

2nd Prize: Rs 2000/-

3rd Prize: Rs 1000/-

- Only one member of each team can participate in JAM.
- Each participant will be given a topic on the spot, and the speaking time will be of one minute.
- Each student will get two minutes for preparing the topic.
- Topics would be picked by the participants from a bowl of chits.
- No hesitation, deviation is allowed while the performance is on.
- Contestants cannot repeat the idea and cannot steal ideas of others.
- The buzzer will be pressed twice. First buzzer will be pressed after 45 seconds have passed and second buzzer will be at the end of one minute, signaling the participants that their turn is over.
- Usage of foul language will lead to negative marking.
- Speak loudly and clear.
- Try not to speak too quickly.
- Participants have to use English and Hindi language only.
- Participants will be judged on the basis of confidence, content and your presentation of idea.

SCIENCE QUIZ

PRIZE MONEY

1st Prize: - Rs 5000/-

2nd Prize: - Rs 3000/-

3rd prize: - Rs 2000/-

Following are the rules of the Science-Quiz:

Prelims:

- Maximum 5 teams will be allowed per school.
- Each team will consist of two members.
- Prelims will be a written format.
- Multiple choice Questions will be there. Each Question will carry 2 Marks.
- No Negative marking will be there.
- It will be a mix from Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, General Science and Technology.

Final Round:

- Best of five teams will be selected for this round.
- The final will consist of 4 rounds:

ROUND 1: Physics
ROUND 2: Chemistry
ROUND 3: Mathematics
ROUND 4: General Science and Technology.
Each team will be asked 2 questions in every round.

Theme of the Competition: Recent Trends in Science and Technology

Sub Themes:

- Educational Technology
 - Energy and its conservation
 - Technology in Health
 - Make in India etc
 - Agriculture

- The participating School can put up only one project/exhibit/model.
 - There can be maximum 3 participants from each school.
 - The exhibit/model/project may be either a working model or an investigation based project related to the theme and may include:
 - Working model to explain a concept, principle or a process.
 - An Indigenous design of a machine/device.
 - An innovation/inexpensive design or technique.
 - Application of basic principles of science/ technology.
 - Scheme/design of a device or machine to reduce production cost.
 - Investigation based study.
 - Display board, extension board, projector, laptop, drawing pins etc. should be arranged by the participating school/ team. Only electrical point will be provided by the Institute.
 - The participating school will have to bear all the expenses of the participation in the event.
 - Two copies of brief write-up about the exhibit/model/project should be prepared and presented at the time of registration and judgment.
 - The decision of the judges will be final.
 - The exhibit/model/project will be assessed by the experts as per the following five criteria (Weightage of 20% each)
 - a. Student own creativity and imagination
 - b. Technical skill/workmanship/craftsmanship
 - c. Utility/educational value
 - d. Presentation-explanation and demonstration
 - e. Science thought

GROUP DISCUSSION

RULES FOR GD:-

- 1) Each group consists of three or four participants.
- 2) In 1st round, each group will be given a time limit not exceeding 10 minutes to discuss on the topic.
- 3) In the time provided (if any) to think and organize, think critically, analyze thoroughly and then try to arrive on the conclusions.
- 4) Irrelevant points and facts should be avoided instead stick to the point with objectivity.
- 5) Opener may ask permission of group that everyone will be given chance to speak once in line and then general discussion starts.
- 6) Always raise hand before speaking.
- 7) Avoid false starts, do not present wrong data or facts or deviate from topic.
- 8) Avoid giving a negative impression.
- 9) Do not shout & maintain etiquettes.
- 10) There will be no negative marking.
- 11) Language can either be Hindi or English.
- 12) Do not interrupt when another member is speaking.
- 13) Shortlisted group will appear in round 2.
- 14) Same rules must be followed in round 2.
- 15) The group with the highest points at the end of round 2 will be declared as the winner.
