

Furthermore, 24 Gold medals representing almost all programs & staring of new programs in Paramedical Sciences are the new addition.


The Institute conducts Alumni meets to get feedback from the old students serving across the globe for further improvements in academics and other related areas based on their experiences and as per the societal expectations.

#### Data Science using Python (1st April 2024)




The Tech Craft Corps Club of the Department of Computer Applications organized a Seminar on "Data Science using Python" on 01-04-2024.

#### LOHRI CELEBRATION


