RULES FOR BASANT FEST

TUG OF WAR

1. Every participant will be bare footed and without any belt or any other material with him/her.
2. There will be eleven members in a team.
3. Girls' Teams will also participate.
4. Team entry will be through Class In-charges only.

MATKA PHOD

1. There will be nine members in each team.
2. Maximum three chances will be given to each Matka team. If the Matka is broken in the first attempt, no further chance will be given to that team.
3. Only boys can participate in the competition.
4. The height of the pole for Matka will be sixteen feet and flowers and toffees will be put in the Matkas.
5. Team entry will be through Class In-charges.

KITE FLYING

1. Chinese string will not be used in kite flying. It is strictly prohibited. Defaulters will be disqualified.
2. Team entry will be through Class In-charges.

1. **Only one team per department is allowed to participate.**
2. The decision of the judges will be final.
3. Students must wear Identity card
