

Department of Fashion Designing: Setting up a Fashion Designing Department requires a blend of creative, technical, physical, and digital infrastructure to support design, production, and presentation. The Global Group of Institutes has a comprehensive list of infrastructure requirements tailored for its newly started course of educational Fashion Designing. The Physical Infrastructure at our design house setup consists of Studios & Classrooms, Design Studio, Spacious, well-lit room for sketching, draping, brainstorming, Pattern-Making Room having Tables, Mannequins, Dress forms of Dummies, 5 JUKI, 5 JACK, 5 USHA sewing machines, an interlocking machine and a steam iron-press. Construction Labs are also well equipped with Screen printing tables, Block printing tables, Fashion boards, and Photography Studio for model shoots and portfolio development.
